The request of the Lithuanian Bishops' Conference – about Ukraine **Vilnius, Lithuania, March 3rd, 2022:**

Dear Lithuanians in the whole world,

When we were preparing the letter “Day of prayer for Lithuanians in the whole world“, no one could have known that Russia would attack Ukraine, and that a war would begin. Many of you were instrumental in the peaceful struggle for the independence and freedom of Lithuania, you helped those who were suffering. We thank you for that. You know how to influence your countries' governments, parliaments and presidents, that they may stand on the side of Liberty and Truth. We invite you, wherever you might live, to join your local Ukrainian communities, and with them to actively pursue and organize efforts to bring peace back to Europe, and to bring the war in Ukraine to an end.

We also invite you to help the victims of the scourge of this war, supporting organizations which are giving such help. May our weapons in this struggle be prayer and concrete good deeds for freedom, for truth, for peace. May God bless Ukraine!
