Reflections from this week's liturgy

Today in the Book of Deuteronomy Moses reminds the people of God, Israel, of all the wonders and prodigies that the Lord manifested to them during their many years in the desert, how God protected them from the heat and the cold, from snakes and scorpions, and how God gave them water which gushed forth from the rocks. But the biggest of God's miracles was the bread He sent from above, the Manna, as food for his people. This heavenly bread not only saved Israel from starvation, but also purified them, since they were not participating in lavish banquets or drinking wine, but only having bread and water, and sometimes meat from birds that God sent them, and the fruits of trees in the oases. As Moses said, and later Jesus repeated: "man does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the lips of God". As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, let us also remember these words and be saved by the heavenly bread.
