Reflections from this week's liturgy

As we read in the Acts of the Apostles, a short time after Christ's death and resurrection, Saint Peter addresses the crowd in Jerusalem and reminds them of the terrible mistake they made: they preferred that Pontius Pilate set free a murderer instead of the Son of God, they rejected the holy one and just one, they killed the author of life, they betrayed the one who was sent to save them, but God exalted Jesus and rose him up from the dead, and Peter and the other apostles are witnesses to this. Then to this heartbroken crowd Peter gives a bit of hope, asking them not to follow the bad example of their leaders, who acted out of ignorance, but to acknowledge their mistake and to convert and to believe in the Messiah, Jesus Christ, and to be baptized in the Holy Spirit. All the prophets predicted this, and we too must suffer with Christ to resurrect with him in God's grace, for eternal life. To live in the grace of God means to abhor evil and to avoid sin, which will open our hearts to practice charity and brotherly love.
