### **Reflections from this week's liturgy**

The Acts of the Apostles introduces us to Saul of Tarsus, who was a Pharisee, taught by Gamaliel in Jerusalem, and a persecutor of the early Church, and who had a miraculous conversion on the road to Damascus. After Saul's conversion and baptism, he went to Jerusalem to meet the apostles and other Christians whom he once aggressively arrested and jailed, but they were afraid of him and shunned him, thinking that he may be trying to deceive them. Only Barnabas received Saul and helped him, and both of them fled Jerusalem and went to Antioch when they found out that the Jerusalem Hellenists (Jews of Greek culture and language) wanted to kill Saul, just as they had killed Stephen, the first Christian martyr. We see that from the very beginning there was division and persecution in the Church, but there was also conversion, and the grace of God accompanied Barnabas and Saul, who later changed his name to Paul (from the Latin adjective “paulus”, meaning small) and became Saint Paul, one of the columns of the Church, Apostle to the Gentiles.
